



## OUT OF SCHOOL TIME PROGRAM

### Program Information

Capital City Public Charter School's Child Care Program is a tuition-based program geared for Pre-K3 through 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. The purpose of the program is to provide a safe, nurturing, and engaging environment for our students while their parents are working. The program supports the physical, intellectual, emotional and social development of each child; and is designed to be consistent in philosophy and structure with the school program. The aim is a stimulating and fun environment for students.

#### **Before and After Care:**

The Before and After Care Program are open on all regular school days beginning:

#### **All Day Care:**

During teacher planning days families have the option of sending their child to **All Day Care**. Participation on these extra days will be limited to students who sign up in advance. There is an additional fee of \$50 per child to participate. Fees will be added to your Tuition Express account and are due with the following month's fees.

**Program Structure and Activities:**

The PreK3-Kindergarten program is uniquely designed for our youngest students enrolled at Capital City. The program will take place in their classrooms and children will enjoy activities like arts and crafts, indoor and outdoor games, lively and engaging read-alouds, dramatic play, writing, science, buddy time with older students, free choice and more.

1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> graders will have a supervised homework period and assistance will be available to support students and promote their success in school. In addition, kids will be able to choose from a variety of core activities like arts and crafts, indoor and outdoor games, computer learning centers, special events, free choice, buddy time and much more. Staff will supervise activities while encouraging students to interact fairly and safely.

5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> graders will have structured study time, participate in outdoor games, and have time to work with their middle school peers in a range of activities. Activities are tailored to the interests and needs of early adolescents. As many middle school students also participate in Capital City after school sports and activities, the program provides flexibility for both students and parents. There are additional activities planned for the weeks that middle school activities are not meeting (gap weeks) and accommodations made for students who come after their middle school activities end.

PK through 5<sup>th</sup>-grade students will also have the opportunity to participate in a wider range of clubs (some for an additional fee) that will be available to the entire Lower School. Aftercare students will have priority registration for clubs. The 'Clubs List' will be sent to families soon and will include things such as: Dance, Science, Sports, Games, Art, Musical Theater and Tae-Kwan-Do.

**Staffing and Supervision:**

We strive to provide the most qualified and trained staff possible. Staff to student ratios approximate the ratios in classes during the school day (about 10:1 for early childhood and 12:1 for older grades). All staff will be provided with training and ongoing professional development and supervision. Steve LeBoo is the Program Director. Please do not hesitate to contact Steve with any questions regarding the program.

**Snack:**

Snacks will be provided to all students. Snacks will be of high quality and healthy. We aim to accommodate most dietary needs. Please indicate any food allergies or dietary restrictions on the registration form.

**Program Tuition/Fees:**

**There is a \$25 annual registration fee per family to participate in the Before and/or After Care.** All families must complete an enrollment form and submit the registration fee prior to a child being accepted in the program. The registration fee is non-refundable. Tuition is an annual rate based on the 180 days of school. School observed holidays and teacher workdays are not included in the calculation of the annual rate. The annual rate is divided into 10 equal monthly installments from August 2019 until May 2020 for ease of payment. The equal monthly installment is due regardless of the number of school days in a month or days of attendance. There will be no refunds due to emergency weather, early school closures, student withdrawn from school, late notification of student withdrawal, change of enrollment or other unpredictable causes. **Payment will always be due on the 15th of the month.**

Monthly tuition must be submitted by the 30<sup>th</sup> for a student to continue in the program. If monthly payment and any other fees are not received by the 30<sup>th</sup> the parent must make other arrangements for childcare. Parents will be notified by the Program Director on a case-by-case basis. The child/children will not be re-enrolled into the program until the past due balance and any additional late fees.

**Tuition Assistance:**

Capital City offers a reduced rate for families who qualify for 'Free and Reduced Priced' meals (listed above.) Proper paperwork must be on file with the Business Office and will be verified. Contact the Program Director to learn more about reduced rates.

**Tuition Express:**

Capital City uses Tuition Express to manage payments. Tuition Express is a secure and convenient server-based software. All accounts are set up for 'Automatic Recurring Payments'

through credit cards, debit cards, or electronic transfer from a savings or checking account. Capital City accepts Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover. There are two payment options listed below. **Families only need to submit one Tuition Express form for either bank account transfer or credit card payments. NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Checks/Money orders will be accepted with approval.

**Drop-In Option:**

The Drop-in option provides flexibility to working parents, allowing children to attend before care or aftercare. **Parents must communicate with the Program Director at least 1 hour prior to the end of the school day to make payment arrangements and to ensure space is available.** *We encourage all families to set up an account in case of an unexpected emergency.*

**Drop-In Procedure:**

1. Parents should email both [sleboo@ccpcs.org](mailto:sleboo@ccpcs.org) and their child’s teachers. Please include your child’s full name, grade, teacher, date you need them to drop in, parents full name, phone number, and indicate who will pick the child up. Specify if the drop-in is for before care or after care.
2. Drop-in payment is processed through Tuition Express. We encourage all CCPCS families to register with Tuition Express. Drop-in Rates are listed below.

**There will be no Drop-In for the first two weeks of school. Drop-In service will begin on Monday, September 16, 2019.**

**Daily Late Pickup Fees:**

*Parents are expected to pick their child/children by 6:00pm.* We understand and recognize there will be times that parents are stuck in traffic, held up by inclement weather, or for other reasons. However, we must charge a late pick-up fee since being late to pick up your child inconveniences our staff and increase our staffing costs.

Late pickup fees are incurred beginning at 6:16 pm. **Fees will be added to accounts and are due with the following month's tuition payment.** Payments can also be made by credit/debit card in the office.

**Repeated late pick-ups are considered grounds for dismissal from the remainder of the program without refund of the monthly fees. Please note charges are per student and will apply to each child.**

**Change of Days and/or Withdraw from Program:**

Parents wishing to 'Withdraw' or 'Change Enrollment' days must contact Steve LeBoo by the 10th of the month. The withdrawal will be effective on the first of the following month. No refunds will be given for the month if a student withdraws mid-month regardless of the number of days attended.

**2019/20 Registration:**

To ensure your child's enrollment for the beginning of the year, please return registrations by **Friday, Aug. 30, 2019. Exceptions will be made only for newly admitted families.**
