About Capital City Public Charter School

Capital City is a Title I school serving a diverse population of more than 1,000 students (75% low-income; 64% Latino, 25% Black, 6% White, 1% Asian, 4% Multiracial) from every Ward in the city. As the first parent-founded public charter school in the District, our nationally-recognized, high-quality program is changing the narrative for predominantly first-generation students of color. 100% of graduates have been accepted to college and our college graduation rate is four times the national average for low-income students. Through the EL Education model, we teach the whole child, emphasizing social-emotional learning and deeper learning skills. We offer a comprehensive arts program, fieldwork and adventure trips, and free after-school activities. Capital City teachers, including the DC 2020 Teacher of the Year, deliver personalized instruction to meet the needs of students of all abilities.
